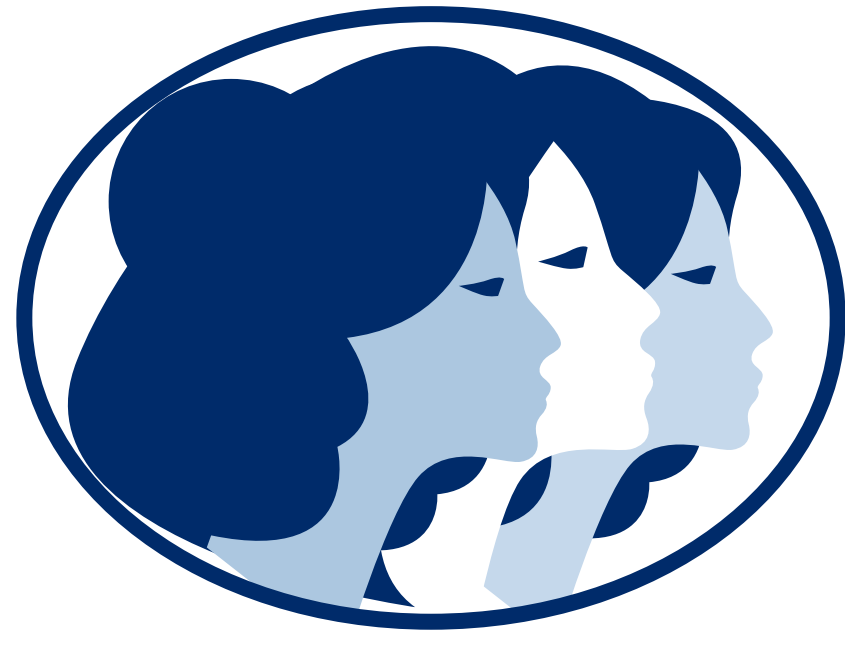
The most significant risk factors for breast cancer are

**have no family history**

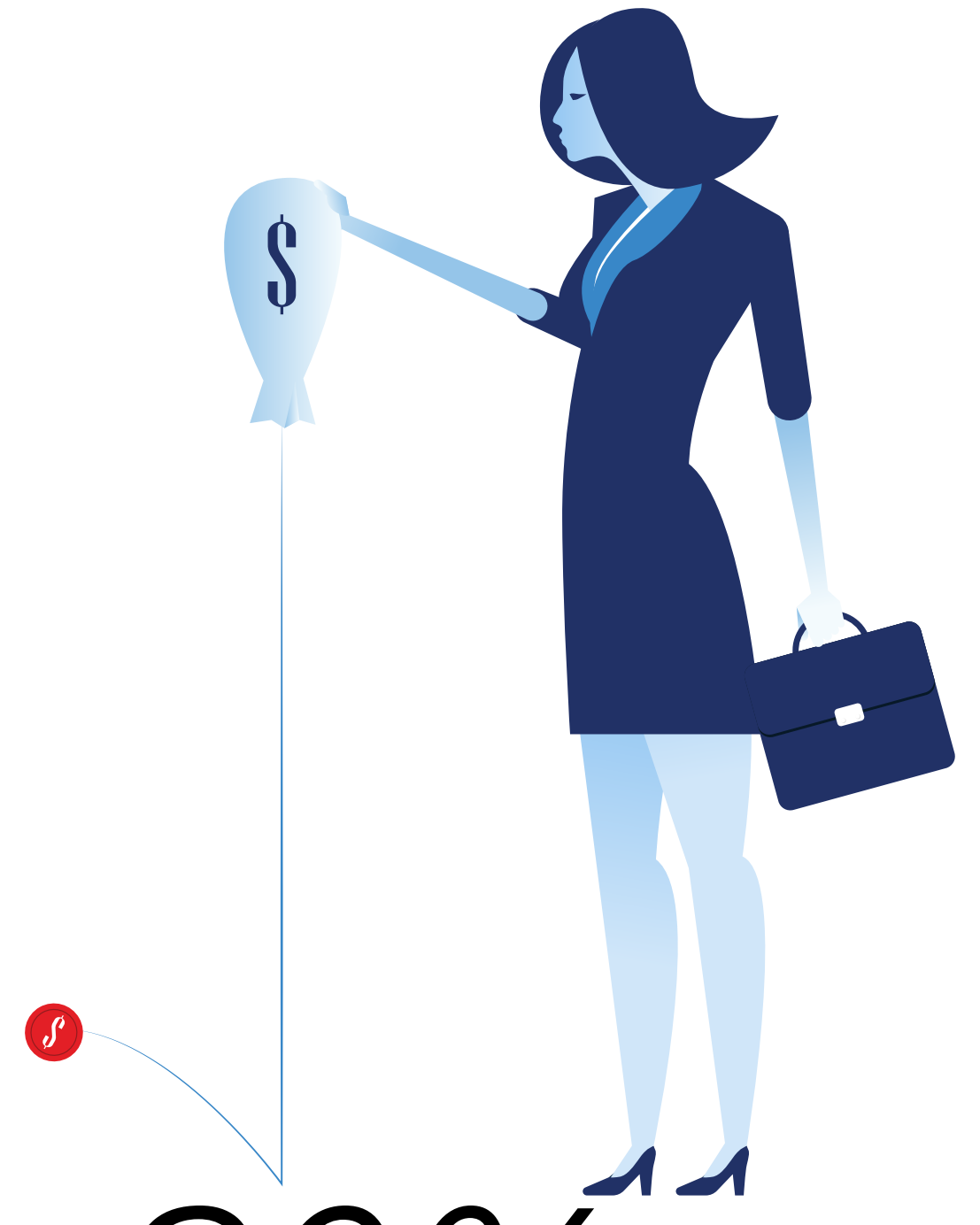
Researchers have found that

**hormone replacement therapy**

increases a woman's risk of breast cancer.

People living with cancer have a **higher risk of financial difficulty** than people without cancer.

Cancer survivors experience **reduced income for 3-5 years** after diagnosis



Up to **80%** of cancer survivors have used their personal savings

Researchers have coined the term

**financial toxicity**

to describe the financial impact of a cancer diagnosis, its treatment, and lasting effects.



Factors influencing long-term financial risk include

overall patient health  
available assets and debt  
household income  
other sources of income
